- 1. Sunday School Leadership** (Preschool & Kindergarten Ministry). Volunteers will serve young children weekly or bi-weekly. They will provide a stable atmosphere for the children and prepare activities and lessons that teach Biblical truth. We have 36 preschool and kindergarten Sunday School classes, with each class needing at least four adults.
